

While this book touches on numerous important public health concerns, it was hard to get past the spelling errors and the choppy thought processes. I was also surprised that, while giving an example of seizures, the author decided to input their interpretation of the Bible. It was very strange. While public health biology can be a hard topic, this book teaches it well. The chapters are shorter than a normal textbook, which makes them manageable (and certainly helps my attitude towards reading them!).
