

In this guiet yet hallucinatory volume, Salinas offers us a prismatic collection of odes, elegies, and cantos of desireâ "complex poems about our place in the world. Poems to be savored in solitude, or better still with an intimate companion. Few poets, Latino or otherwise, are as daring with love poetry that is so honestly fierce. Salinas gives us a meditation on gently aging while continuing to celebrate personal experience that draws upon the world. One need only sample these rich, elegant stanzas to recognize the wealth of wisdom found in their words. Elegy for Desire is a testament to a singular talent that has survived for decades . . . and will continue to inspire long beyond his lifetime. The dead canâ ™t complain, and lovers always do. Well, lâ ™m here, and that is important. And if life can be as exciting as this, I must be doing something right.
